#### A Message from Fr. Paul Respecting the Sanctity of the Eucharist Celebration


The Eucharistic celebration holds a central place in Catholic life. It is a celebration that reminds us about Jesus Christ's sacrifice on the altar of the cross and embodies the true presence of Jesus Christ among believers feeding them with his divinity. Within this context the principles of courtesy and respect are expected from participants of the Eucharistic celebration.

Unfortunately one of the often overlooked aspects of respect during the Eucharistic celebration is the prohibition against chewing gum. Code of Canon law (Canon 919.1) tells Catholics that they are to abstain from all food and drink (with the exception of water or medicine) for at least one hour before receiving Holy Communion. The reason, of course, is to remind us how special the Eucharist is, nourishing us for eternal life. It is something different from regular food or drink that we consume.

Chewing gum - simply saying is breaking that fast and it is a reason to NOT receive Holy Communion. The act of receiving the Eucharist is a moment of profound significance, symbolizing our communion with Christ and the Church. Engaging in behaviors like chewing gum during this time expresses a lack of reverence for the sacredness of the moment and it also expresses lack of respect for the received body of Christ.

It is important to be mindful of our actions within the church that they always express and foster a sense of reverence and respect for the divine nature of place and moment. Let us remember to observe guidelines of courtesy and respect, by doing so we not only honor the sanctity of the Eucharistic celebration but also deepen our personal faith and relationship with Christ.
